DIRECTIONS - From State Rt #33....

- 1. Take Exit #664 North into Logan (by WalMart)**
- 2. Continue north on #664 (pass WalMart on right, Old Dutch on left) and continue down the hill and over the bridge, keeping in the right lane**
- 3. Turn right at the light on Hunter Street**
- 4. Go thru several lights, until you see a fork in the road. State Farm Insurance has a building in the center of the fork.**
- 5. Take the right fork, on to Main Street. You will see the Festival straight ahead.**
- 6. Pass the Feed Mill on the right**
- 7. Turn right at the Stop sign, just past the Feed Mill on to Gallagher Avenue**
- 8. The Columbus Washboard Factory will be on your left**
Note the 'largest washboard in the world' on the side of the building!
- 9. Drop your group off on the sidewalk to tour the Factory. The Factory opens at 12:00 noon for tours.**
- 10. Drive into the parking area in the field on your right, just across from the Factory.**
